Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 12 Sec. 7-112.5. Training tuition. The Department is
- 13 <u>authorized to charge tuition to non-governmental entities</u>,
- 14 other than not for profit groups or organizations in Illinois
- that have no more than 50 employees, for training offered by
- 16 the Department's Institute for Training and Development. The
- 17 tuition shall be paid into the Department of Human Rights
- 18 Training and Development Fund, a special fund that is created
- in the State treasury. Moneys in the Fund shall be used to: (i)
- 20 enhance the quality of the Department's training services; (ii)
- 21 make training available at no cost to not for profit groups or

- 1 organizations in Illinois that have no more than 50 employees,
- 2 Department employees, other State agencies and
- 3 instrumentalities of the State, and community organizations;
- and (iii) make training available to any other non-governmental 4
- 5 entities on a tuition basis.
