Amend House Bill 2573 as follows: 3 on page 2, by replacing lines 2 through 8 with the following: "to contact the Department; (vii) protection against 4 retaliation as provided by Section 6-101 of this Act; (viii) 5 every institution of higher education shall post and keep 6 7 posted at each campus in common area positions easily accessible to all students including, but not limited to 8 residence halls, administration buildings, student unions, 9 cafeterias, and libraries or (ix) every institution of higher 10 11 education shall post annually at each campus in common area positions easily accessible to all students including, but not 12 13 limited to residence halls, administration buildings, student unions, cafeterias, and libraries, in addition to including an 14 15 electronic notice to each student at the time that registration
