

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 HB2683

Introduced 2/24/2009, by Rep. Rosemary Mulligan

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 130/4-10 new

Amends the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 1984. Requires the Legislative Research Unit, by December 1 of each year, to prepare and file a report listing any statutes or State programs or portions of statutes or programs that are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other State or federal statutes or programs. The report must also include (i) an explanation of why all or part of the statute or program is obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative and (ii) a timetable for repeal of all or part of the statute or program. The report also must identify the status of any statutes or programs identified in the prior year's report. The report must be filed with the Clerk of the House, the Secretary of the Senate, and the Legislative Reference Bureau and also with the Office of the Governor for distribution to affected State agencies.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 1984 is amended by adding Section 4-10 as follows:
- 6 (25 ILCS 130/4-10 new)
- 7 Sec. 4-10. Review of statutes and programs. By December 1 of each year, the Legislative Research Unit must prepare and 8 9 file a report listing any statutes or State programs or portions of statutes or programs that are obsolete, 10 unnecessary, or duplicative of other State or federal statutes 11 12 or programs. The report must also include (i) an explanation of why all or part of the statute or program is obsolete, 13 14 unnecessary, or duplicative of other State or federal statutes or programs and (ii) a timetable for repeal of all or part of 15 the statute or program. The report also must identify the 16 17 status of any statutes or programs identified in the prior year's report as obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative. The 18 19 report shall be filed with the Clerk of the House, the Secretary of the Senate, and the Legislative Reference Bureau 20 21 and also with the Office of the Governor for distribution to 22 affected State agencies.
