AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing
Section 8-101 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 5/8-101) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 8-101)

Sec. 8-101. Duties of public utilities; nondiscrimination.
A public utility shall furnish, provide, <u>and and maintain such</u>
service instrumentalities, equipment, and facilities as shall
promote the safety, health, comfort, and convenience of its
patrons, employees, and public and as shall be in all respects
adequate, efficient, just, and reasonable.

All rules and regulations made by a public utility affecting or pertaining to its charges or service to the public shall be just and reasonable.

A public utility shall, upon reasonable notice, furnish to all persons who may apply therefor and be reasonably entitled thereto, suitable facilities and service, without discrimination and without delay.

Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prevent a public utility from accepting payment electronically or by the use of a customer-preferred financially accredited credit or debit methodology. HB3222
