1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3258 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 3258 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The Illinois Speech-Language Pathology and 4 Audiology Practice Act is amended by changing Section 8.6 as 5 6 follows: 7 (225 ILCS 110/8.6) (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018) 8 8.6. Minimum requirements for speech-language 9 10 pathology assistant programs. 11 (a) An applicant for licensure as a speech-language 12 pathology assistant must have earned 60 semester credit hours 13 in a program of study that includes general education and the specific knowledge and skills for a speech-language pathology 14

assistant. The curriculum of a speech-language pathology

assistant program must include all of the following content, as

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- further provided by rule promulgated by the Department:
 - (1) <u>Twenty-four</u> <u>Thirty-six</u> semester credit hours in general education.
 - Thirty-six Twenty-four semester credit hours in technical content areas designed to provide students with skills required for knowledge and speech-language pathology assistants, which must include (i) an overview of normal processes of communication; (ii) an overview of communication disorders; (iii) instruction in speech-language pathology assistant-level service delivery practices; (iv) instruction in workplace behaviors; (v) cultural and linguistic factors in communication; and (vi) observation.
 - (3) Completion of at least 100 hours of supervised field work experiences supervised by a licensed speech-language pathologist at least 50% of the time when the student is engaged in contact with the patient or client. An applicant must obtain written verification demonstrating successful completion of the required field work experience, including a description of the setting in which the training was received and an assessment of the student's technical proficiency.
 - (b) The Department may promulgate rules that change the curriculum requirements of subsection (a) in order to reflect the guidelines for speech-language pathology assistant programs recommended by the American Speech-Language Hearing
