# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much of that amount as necessary, is appropriated to the Department of 5 Public Health from the General Revenue Fund to fund the 6 activities and costs associated with the Universal Newborn 7 Of these dollars, \$1,200,000 or 60% shall 8 Hearing Program. 9 be provided to the University of Illinois Division of Specialized Care for Children and Department 10 of Human Services Early Intervention Program through interagency 11 agreements in order to fund portions of the Program related 12 diagnostic care or early intervention services 13 for to 14 children identified as having potential hearing loss under the Program and for parent-to-parent involvement support. 15 Expenditures of the dollars appropriated under this Act shall 16 reported to the Universal Newborn Hearing Screening 17 be Advisory Committee created by the Hearing Screening for 18 19 Newborns Act.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2009.
