- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing 5 Section 12-602.1 as follows:
- (625 ILCS 5/12-602.1) 6
- 7 Sec. 12-602.1. Excessive engine braking noise signs.
- 8 (a) A county or municipality may post signs that prohibit
- the driver of a commercial vehicle, as defined in Section 1-111.8 of this Code, from operating or actuating any engine
- braking system that emits excessive noise. The Department of 11
- 12 Transportation may erect and maintain the signs on interstate
- highways near weigh stations that are adjacent to residential 13
- 14 areas or communities.

- (b) The sign shall state, "EXCESSIVE ENGINE BRAKING NOISE 15 PROHIBITED". The Department of Transportation shall adopt 16 17 rules providing for the erection and placement of these signs.
 - (c) This Section does not apply to the use of an engine braking system that has an adequate sound muffling system in proper working order that prevents excessive noise.
- 21 (d) It is a defense to this Section that the driver used an 22 engine braking system that emits excessive noise in an emergency to avoid a collision with a person or another vehicle 23

- 1 on the highway.
- 2 (e) A violation of this Section is an equipment violation
- 3 punishable by a fine of \$75.
