Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 8 Conflict veterans; diplomas.
- 9 (a) Upon request, the school board of any district that
- 10 maintains grades 10 through 12 may award a diploma to any
- 11 honorably discharged veteran who:
- 12 (1) served in the armed forces of the United States
- during World War II or the Korean Conflict or the Vietnam
- 14 <u>Conflict;</u>
- 15 (2) resided within an area currently within the district;
- 17 (3) left high school before graduating in order to 18 serve in the armed forces of the United States; and
- 19 (4) has not received a high school diploma.
- 20 (b) The State Board of Education and the Department of
- 21 Veterans' Affairs may issue rules consistent with the
- 22 provisions of this Section that are necessary to implement this
- 23 Section.
