SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/21-1.6 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of domestic damage to property when a person knowingly or intentionally causes damage to a family or household member's personal property or commonly owned property while in the immediate presence of that family or household member so as to deliberately and intentionally intimidate or threaten that family or household member. Requires a peace officer to arrest the offender upon the establishment of probable cause. Makes the offense a Class A misdemeanor.

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
Section 21-1.6 as follows:

(720 ILCS 5/21-1.6 new) 6 7 Sec. 21-1.6. Domestic damage to property. (a) A person commits domestic damage to property when he or 8 9 she knowingly or intentionally causes damage to a family or household member's personal property or commonly owned 10 property while in the immediate presence of that family or 11 12 household member, as defined in subsection (3) of Section 112A-3 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963, so as to 13 14 deliberately and intentionally intimidate or threaten that family or household member. A peace officer must arrest the 15 16 offender upon the establishment of probable cause. 17 (b) Sentence. Domestic damage to property is a Class A

18 misdemeanor.
