Persons who 5 apply to register to vote by mail but provide inadequate proof 6 of identity to the election authority shall be notified by the election authority that the registration has not been fully 7 8 completed and that the person remains ineligible to vote by 9 mail or in person until such proof is presented.

10 (b) The following forms of identification and proof of 11 residency shall be deemed sufficient for the purposes of this Section and for persons voting for the first time after 12 13 registering at a Secretary of State driver's license facility: (i) a university or college issued photo identification card, 14 15 with either a copy of the applicant's lease or any mail, showing the delivery address, delivered to the applicant at 16 that address, or (ii) a government issued photo identification 17 card. The State Board shall post a list of these specific forms 18 of identification and proof of residency on its official 19 20 website, and printed copies shall be distributed at the time of registration to each person who registers by mail or at a 21 22 Secretary of State driver's license facility.

1 (a) A person must vote for the first time in person and not 2 by a mailed absentee ballot if the person registered to vote by 3 mail, unless the person first provides the appropriate election 4 authority with sufficient proof of identity and the election 5 authority verifies the person's proof of identity. Sufficient 6 proof of identity shall be demonstrated by submission of the person's driver's license number or State identification card 7 number or, if the person does not have either of those, 8 9 verification by the last 4 digits of the person's social 10 security number, a copy of a current and valid photo 11 identification, or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government 12 13 document that shows the person's name and address. Persons who apply to register to vote by mail but provide inadequate proof 14 15 of identity to the election authority shall be notified by the 16 election authority that the registration has not been fully completed and that the person remains ineligible to vote by 17 mail or in person until such proof is presented. 18

9 (a) A person must vote for the first time in person and not 10 by a mailed absentee ballot if the person registered to vote by mail, unless the person first provides the appropriate election 11 authority with sufficient proof of identity and the election 12 authority verifies the person's proof of identity. Sufficient 13 14 proof of identity shall be demonstrated by submission of the 15 person's driver's license number or State identification card number or, if the person does not have either of those, 16 verification by the last 4 digits of the person's social 17 18 security number, a copy of a current and valid photo 19 identification, or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government 20 21 document that shows the person's name and address.
