Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 2 Section 25. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants

- 6 contracts and grants moneys received.
- 7 Section 30. The sum of \$2,800,000, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Budget Relief Fund
- 9 to the Board of Higher Education for the administration and
- 10 distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying Higher
- 11 Education Faculty in Illinois Program.
- 12 Section 35. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 14 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
- 15 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of
- 16 higher education.
- 17 Section 40. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 19 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants
- 20 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating
- 21 nurses.

- 1 Section 45. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 3 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator
- 4 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.
- 5 Section 50. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 7 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
- 8 with the High Need Health Occupations Program.
- 9 Section 55. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
- 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 11 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
- 12 with the u.Select System.
- 13 Section 60. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 15 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs associated
- with the Integrated P-20 Student Information System.
- 17 Section 65. The following named amounts, or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
- 19 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the

- Section 75. The sum of \$650,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy for the Excellence 2000 Program in Mathematics and Science.
- Section 80. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy for costs associated with the opening of the Chicago and East St. Louis Metro-East field offices.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
