A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations and reappropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
7 of the Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to meet
8 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
9 June 30, 2010:

10 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:

11	For Personal Services, including payment	
12	to the university for personal services	
13	costs incurred during the fiscal year	
14	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic	
15	personnel for personal services rendered	
16	during the 2009-2010 academic year	\$51,581,300
17	For Contractual Services	1,000,000
18	For Commodities	300,000
19	For Equipment	500,000
20	For Telecommunications Services	<u>300,000</u>
21	Total	\$53,681,300

22 Section 10. The sum of \$4,250, or so much thereof as may

1 be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
2 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern
3 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
4 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

5 Section 15. The sum of \$1,346,621, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
7 business on June 30, 2009, from a reappropriation heretofore
8 made for such purpose in Article 38, Section 5 of Public Act
9 95-734, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
10 to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to
11 purchase equipment for the renovation and expansion of the
12 Fine Arts Center. No contract shall be entered into or
13 obligation incurred for any expenditure from the
14 appropriation made in this Section until after the purpose
15 and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
17 2009.
