1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The amount of \$25,000,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Capital Development Board for grants for architectural and engineering studies and construction of a cooperative high school in Vermilion County involving Jamaica High School, Oakwood High School, and Catlin High School.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2009.
