1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$8,750,000, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of  
6 Corrections from the General Revenue Fund for a grant to  
7 Operation Ceasefire to be used in the following locations:
