general public may access the drug testing results."; and 1 2 on page 7, by deleting lines 1 through 18; and 3 on page 13, by replacing lines 1 through 2 with the following: 4 "(d) The substance abuse testing authorized and required by this Section does not apply to any resident of a facility 5 licensed or permitted under the Nursing Home Care Act, the Life 6 7 Care Facility Act, the Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act, 8 the MR/DD Community Care Act, or a facility designated as a 9 supportive living facility under Section 5-5.01a of the Illinois Public Aid Code."; and 10 on page 14, by replacing lines 7 through 10 with the following: 11 12 "(d) The substance abuse testing authorized and required by this Section does not apply to any resident of a facility 13 licensed or permitted under the Nursing Home Care Act, the Life 14
