SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$7,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant to EdgeAlliance for costs associated with the construction of a 36-unit permanent supporting housing facility. Appropriates \$4,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant to EdgeAlliance for costs associated with the construction of a health and wellness center for use by EdgeAlliance residents and residents who are veterans. Effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant
7 to EdgeAlliance for costs associated with the construction of
8 a 36-unit permanent supporting housing facility.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much of that
10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
11 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant
12 to EdgeAlliance for costs associated with the construction of
13 a health and wellness center for use by EdgeAlliance
14 residents and residents who are veterans.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
16 2009.
