Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of special State University Police license plates for vehicles owned by a State university or State university police force.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 3-684 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-684 new)

7 Sec. 3-684. State University Police license plates.

8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of a request from a  
9 university in this State, accompanied by an application and the  
10 appropriate fee, may issue, to a State university police force,  
11 special registration plates designated as State University  
12 Police license plates. The special plates issued under this  
13 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the  
14 first division or motor vehicles of the second division  
15 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, owned by a State  
16 university or State university police force. Plates issued  
17 under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year  
18 procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

19 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be  
20 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. The plates are  
21 not required to designate "Land of Lincoln" as prescribed in  
22 subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary may  
23 prescribe rules governing the requirements and approval of the

1 special plates. The fee for this plate shall be the same as the  
2 fee prescribed for first division vehicles in Section 3-806 of  
3 this Code.
