SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1305/1-37 new

Amends the Department of Human Services Act. Requires the Department of Human Services, in cooperation with the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, to develop and implement a streamlined auditing and accreditation system to reduce the need for community providers to undergo audits from multiple licensing or accreditation systems. Provides that the streamlined system shall, to the extent possible, utilize one auditing group to provide uniformity from one organization to the next and from one year to the next.

In an effort to reduce administrative costs associated with multiple and duplicative 8 9 program and accreditation audits, the Department, in cooperation with the Department of Healthcare and Family 10 Services, shall develop and implement a streamlined auditing 11 and accreditation system to reduce the need for community 12 providers to undergo audits from multiple licensing or 13 14 accreditation systems. To the extent possible, the streamlined system shall utilize one auditing group to provide uniformity 15 16 from one organization to the next and from one year to the 17 next.
