SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/8-304.5 new

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Provides that the Illinois Commerce Commission shall require that an electric utility with less than 2 million customers set the due date on the bills of non-residential customers to no less than 20 days after the date of the postmark on the bill.

- 11 non-residential customers to no less than 20 days after the
- date of the postmark on the bill.
