SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/2-3.153 new 105 ILCS 5/10-20.53 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.45 new

Amends the School Code. Subject to funding by the State Board of Education, provides that a school board shall require a school to provide recordings for its blind and dyslexic students. Requires the State Board to provide funding to school districts for the provision of recordings for blind and dyslexic students. Effective immediately.

 2-3.153, 10-20.53, and 34-18.45 as follows:

 7 Sec. 2-3.153. Recordings for blind and dyslexic students;
 8 funding. The State Board of Education shall provide funding to

- 11 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.53 new) 12 <u>Sec. 10-20.53. Recordings for blind and dyslexic students.</u> 13 <u>Subject to funding by the State Board of Education, a school</u> 14 <u>board shall require a school to provide recordings for its</u> 15 <u>blind and dyslexic students.</u>
- 16 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.45 new) 17 <u>Sec. 34-18.45. Recordings for blind and dyslexic students.</u> 18 <u>Subject to funding by the State Board of Education, the board</u> 19 <u>shall require a school to provide recordings for its blind and</u> 20 <u>dyslexic students.</u>

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Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
