AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
Section 16G-25 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/16G-25)

Sec. 16G-25. Offenders interest in the property, consent.

8 (a) It is no defense to a charge of aggravated identity 9 theft or identity theft <u>that</u> the offender has an interest 10 in the credit, money, goods, services, or other property.

11 (b) It is no defense to a charge of aggravated identity 12 theft or identity theft that the offender received the consent 13 of any person to access any personal identification information 14 or personal identification document, other than the person 15 described by the personal identification information or 16 personal identification document used by the offender.
