Amends the Illinois Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act. In the definition of "raw agricultural commodity", includes honey, whether on the comb, extracted, churned, or in crystallized form. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act is 5 amended by changing Section 2.18 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 620/2.18) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 502.18)

Sec. 2.18. "Raw agricultural commodity" means any food in its raw or natural state, including all fruits that are washed, colored or otherwise treated in their unpeeled natural form before marketing <u>and honey</u>, whether on the comb, extracted, churned, or in crystallized form.
