SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 620/21.4 new

Amends the Illinois Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act. Provides that the Department of Public Health may not regulate the practice of extracting honey from a bee comb by a beekeeper, nor may the Department regulate or inspect honey houses. Defines "honey house" as any stationary or portable building, or any room or place within a building, used for the purpose of extracting, processing, or other handling of honey. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 21.4 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 620/21.4 new)
- 7 Sec. 21.4. Honey. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 8 this Act, the Department may not regulate the practice of
- 9 extracting honey from a bee comb by a beekeeper, nor may the
- 10 Department regulate or inspect honey houses. As used in this
- 11 Section, "honey house" means any stationary or portable
- building, or any room or place within a building, used for the
- purpose of extracting, processing, or other handling of honey.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
