## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 505/3

from Ch. 31, par. 43

Amends the Autopsy Act. Provides that an autopsy may only be performed in a hospital or a facility maintained by a coroner. Provides that records shall be retained for as long as other medical records at the place the autopsy is performed. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Autopsy Act is amended by changing Section 3
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 505/3) (from Ch. 31, par. 43)
- 7 Sec. 3. The authorized personnel of a hospital or other
- 8 qualified personnel selected by a physician may assist a
- 9 physician performing an autopsy. An autopsy may only be
- 10 performed in a hospital or a facility maintained by a coroner.
- 11 All records and documentation, including pathology slides and
- 12 all examined specimens, shall be retained for as long as other
- medical records at the place the autopsy is performed.
