1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Laser

Speed Detection Device Act.

5. Admissibility of evidence; laser detection device. Evidence of speed based on a speed detection device using the speed timing principle of laser which is of a model that has been approved by the Department of State Police shall be considered scientifically acceptable and reliable as a speed detection device and shall be admissible for all purposes in any court or administrative proceeding in this State, subject to the rules of evidence that are applicable to that court. proceeding, including rules requiring or the establishment of an adequate foundation for the evidence. A certified copy of the Department of State Police list of models of laser devices approved such shall self-authenticating and shall be admissible for all purposes in any court or administrative proceeding in this State. The technology used by any such approved device shall not be considered new or novel for the purposes of detecting speed of a vehicle.
