The Drug Paraphernalia Control Act is amended 4 5 by changing Section 2 as follows: (720 ILCS 600/2) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 2102) 6 7 Sec. 2. As used in this Act, unless the context otherwise 8 requires: (a) The term "cannabis" shall have the meaning ascribed to 10 it in Section 3 of the Cannabis Control Act, as if that definition were incorporated herein. 11 (b) The term "controlled substance" shall have the meaning 12 13 ascribed to it in Section 102 of the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, as if that definition were incorporated herein. 14 15 (c) "Deliver" or "delivery" means the actual, constructive attempted transfer of possession, with or without 16

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- 1 consideration, whether or not there is an agency relationship.
- 2 (d) "Drug paraphernalia" means all equipment, products and 3 materials of any kind, other than methamphetamine 4 manufacturing materials as defined in Section 10 of the 5 Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act, which are intended to be used unlawfully in planting, propagating, 6 cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing, compounding, 7 8 converting, producing, processing, preparing, 9 analyzing, packaging, repackaging, storing, containing, 10 concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling or otherwise 11 introducing into the human body cannabis or a controlled substance in violation of the Cannabis Control Act, the 12 13 Illinois Controlled Substances Act, or the Methamphetamine 14 Control and Community Protection Act. It includes, but is not 15 limited to:
  - (1) kits intended to be used unlawfully in manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing or preparing cannabis or a controlled substance;
  - (2) isomerization devices intended to be used unlawfully in increasing the potency of any species of plant which is cannabis or a controlled substance;
  - (3) testing equipment intended to be used unlawfully in a private home for identifying or in analyzing the strength, effectiveness or purity of cannabis or controlled substances;

1	(4) diluents and adulterants intended to be used
2	unlawfully for cutting cannabis or a controlled substance
3	by private persons;
4	(5) objects intended to be used unlawfully in
5	ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing cannabis,
6	cocaine, hashish, or hashish oil into the human body
7	including, where applicable, the following items:
8	(A) water pipes;
9	(B) carburetion tubes and devices;
10	(B-1) individual tobacco wrappers, known as wraps,
11	blunt wraps, or roll your own cigar wraps, whether in
12	the form of a sheet or tube, that consists in whole or
13	in part of reconstituted tobacco leaf or flavored
14	tobacco leaf; however, the term "wrap", "blunt wrap",
15	or "roll your own cigar wrap", as used in this Section,
16	does not include a tobacco leaf wrap that is used in
17	the manufacturing of a cigar intended for retail sale;
18	(C) smoking and carburetion masks;
19	(D) miniature cocaine spoons and cocaine vials;
20	(E) carburetor pipes;
21	(F) electric pipes;
22	(G) air-driven pipes;
23	(H) chillums;
24	(I) bongs;
25	(J) ice pipes or chillers;
26	(6) any item whose purpose, as announced or described

- 1 by the seller, is for use in violation of this Act.
