A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the
8 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent
9 expenses:

5 Section 10. The sum of \$403,896,100, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for
8 payment of Monetary Award Program grant awards to students
9 eligible to receive such awards, as provided by law.

10 Section 11. The sum of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
12 Assistance Commission from the Education Assistance Fund for
13 payment of military veterans' scholarships at state-
14 controlled universities and at public community colleges for
15 students eligible, as provided by law.

16 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
18 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student
19 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

20 Grants and Scholarships
21 For payment of matching grants to Illinois
22 institutions to supplement scholarship

1	programs, as provided by law	950,000
2	For the payment of scholarships to students	
3	who are children of policemen or firemen	
4	killed in the line of duty, or who are

22 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
 23 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 24 Illinois National Guard and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the

1 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
2 purpose:

3 Grants and Scholarships

4 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
5 Naval Militia Scholarships
6 at State-controlled universities
7 and public community colleges in
8 Illinois to students eligible to
9 receive such awards, as provided by law20,000

10 Section 25. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
12 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the
13 Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

14 Section 40. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as my
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
16 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs
17 associated with the Veterans' Home Nurses' Loan Repayment
18 Program pursuant to Public Act 95-0576.

19 Section 45. The sum of \$300,000 or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
21 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for grants to
22 eligible nurse educators to use for payment of their

1 educational loan pursuant to Public Act 94-1020.

2 Section 50. The following named amount, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
4 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
5 for the following purpose:

6 Grants and Scholarships
7 For payment of Illinois Future Teacher
8 Corps Scholarships, as provided by law2,000,000

9 Section 55. The following named amount, or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
11 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
12 Commission for the following purpose:

13 To support outreach, research, and
14 training activities25,000,000

15 Section 60. The following named amount, or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
17 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the
18 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
19 purpose:

20 Grants and Scholarships
21 For payment of scholarships for the
22 Optometric Education Scholarship

1 Program, as provided by law50,000

2 Section 65. The sum of \$290,000,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
4 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
5 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for
6 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection
7 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under
8 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for
9 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default
10 Aversion Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for
11 other distributions as necessary and provided for under the
12 Federal Higher Education Act.

13 Section 70. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
15 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
16 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment
17 of collection agency fees associated with collection
18 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default
19 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary
20 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

21 Section 75. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student

1 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
2 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and
3 Maintenance.

4 Section 80. The following named amount, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Student
6 Loan Operating Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
7 Commission for the following purposes:

8 For payments to the Federal Student
9 Loan Fund for payment of the federal
10 default fee on behalf of students,
11 or for any other lawful purpose
12 authorized by the Federal Higher
13 Education Act, as amended.....10,000,000

14 Section 85. The sum of \$300,000, or so much of that
15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts
16 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
17 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent
18 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
19 Act of 1986.

20 Section 90. The following named amount, or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
22 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student

1 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

2 For payment of Robert C. Byrd

3 Honors Scholarships3,000,000

4 Section 95. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
6 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
7 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
8 Program, as provided by law.

9 Section 100. The following named amount, or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
11 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
12 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

13 For transferring repayment funds collected

14 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship

15 Program to the U.S. Treasury400,000

16 Section 105. The following named amount, or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
18 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the
19 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
20 purpose:

21 For payment of scholarships for the

22 Illinois Future Teacher Corps

1 Scholarship Program as provided by law57,000
 2 For payment for grants to the Golden Apple
 3 Foundation for Excellence in Teaching3,000

4 Section 110. The following named amount, or so much
 5 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
 6 Student Incentive Trust Fund for the Federal Leveraging
 7 Educational Assistance and the Supplemental Leveraging
 8 Educational Assistance Programs to the Illinois Student
 9 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

10 Grants

11 For payment of Monetary Award Program grants to
 12 full-time and part-time students eligible
 13 to receive such grants, as provided by law4,000,000

14 Section 115. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 16 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 17 Commission for payment of grants for the Federal College
 18 Access Challenge Grant Program, with up to six percent of the
 19 funding appropriated to meet allowable administrative costs,
 20 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act (CCRAA),
 21 as provided by law.

22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
