The Department, with the consent in writing from the Governor, may reappropriation not more than four percent of the total General Revenue Fund appropriations in Section 10 above among the various purposes therein enumerated.

Section 70. The amount of \$10,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services from the Medical Special Purposes Trust Fund for medical demonstration projects and costs associated with the implementation of federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act mandates.

The amount of \$30,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services from the Medical Special Purposes Trust Fund for a Health Information Technology Initiative pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, including grant expenditures, operating and administrative costs and related distributive purposes.

Section 75. The amount of \$200,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the

1 Department of Healthcare and Family Services from the Special
2 Education Medicaid Matching Fund for grants to local
3 education agencies for medical services and other costs
4 eligible for federal reimbursement under Title XIX or Title
5 XXI of the federal Social Security Act.

6 Section 80. In addition to any amounts heretofore

8 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of
9 Healthcare and Family Services from the Money Follows the

13 Project. Such costs shall include, but not necessarily be
