 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
 3 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,  
 4 rehabilitation, and nonrecurring repairs and maintenance of  
 5 the interior and exterior of the various buildings and  
 6 facilities under the jurisdiction of the Office of the  
 7 Secretary of State, including sidewalks, terraces, and  
 8 grounds and all labor, materials, and other costs incidental  
 9 to the above work:

10           From General Revenue Fund .....425,000

11           Section 15. The sum of \$575,000, or so much of this  
 12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital  
 13 Development Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for  
 14 new construction and alterations, and maintenance of the  
 15 interiors and exteriors of the following facilities under the  
 16 jurisdiction of the Secretary of State: Chicago West  
 17 Facility, 5301 N. Lexington Ave., Chicago, Illinois 60644;  
 18 Roger McAuliffe Facility, 5401 N. Elston Ave., Chicago,  
 19 Illinois 60630; Charles Chew Jr. Facility, 9901 S. King  
 20 Drive, Chicago, Illinois 60628; and Capitol Complex buildings

22           Section 15.5. The sum of \$1,511,071, or so much thereof  
 23 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of

3 15 of Public Act 96-0046, is reappropriated from the Capital  
4 Development Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for  
5 new construction and alterations, and maintenance of the  
6 interiors and exteriors of the following facilities under the  
7 jurisdiction of the Secretary of State: Chicago West  
8 Facility, 5301 N. Lexington Ave., Chicago, Illinois 60644;

13 Section 20. The amount of \$40,000, or so much thereof as

15 Facility Maintenance Fund to the Secretary of State for the  
16 maintenance of parking facilities owned or operated by the  
17 Secretary of State.

18 Section 25. The following amounts, or so much of these  
19 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
20 to the Office of the Secretary of State for the following  
21 purposes:

22 For annual equalization grants, per capita and  
23 area grants to library systems, and per

1     capita grants to public libraries, under  
 2     Section 8 of the Illinois Library System  
 3     Act. This amount is in addition to any  
 4     amount otherwise appropriated to the Office

1           Section 75.       In addition to any other amounts  
 2       appropriated for such purposes, the sum of \$1,536,300, or so  
 3       much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from  
 4       the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of  
 5       State for a grant to the Chicago Public Library.

6           Section 80.       The sum of \$325,000, or so much of this  
 7       amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
 8       Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all  
 9       expenditures and grants to libraries for the Project Next  
 10       Generation Program.

11          Section 85.       The following amount, or so much of this  
 12       amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
 13       the Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the  
 14       purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donations:

15          From Live and Learn Fund .....1,750,000

16          Section 90.       The sum of \$50,000, or so much of this amount  
 17       as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of  
 18       State Special License Plate Fund to the Office of the  
 19       Secretary of State for grants to benefit Illinois Veterans  
 20       Home libraries.

21          Section 95.       The amount of \$50,000, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
2 the Secretary of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide  
3 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention  
4 of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-  
5 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model  
6 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in  
7 Illinois.

8 Section 100. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
10 from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants  
11 for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American  
12 fraternities and sororities.

13 Section 105. The amount of \$25,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
15 from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants  
16 for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School  
17 Programming.

18 Section 110. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof  
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of  
20 State from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to  
21 provide grants for the development of tourism, education,  
22 preservation and promotion of Route 66.

1           Section 115. The sum of \$200,000, or so much of this  
 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police  
 3 Memorial Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of  
 4 State for grants to the Police Memorial Committee for  
 5 maintaining a memorial statue, holding an annual memorial  
 6 commemoration, and giving scholarships to children of police  
 7 officers killed in the line of duty.

8           Section 120. The sum of \$130,000, or so much of this  
 9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 10 Mammogram Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for  
 11 grants to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer  
 12 research, education, screening, and treatment.

13           Section 125. The following amounts, or so much of these  
 14 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
 15 to the Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in  
 16 Section 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for  
 17 grants to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-  
 18 America Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of  
 19 organ and tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in  
 20 addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office  
 21 of the Secretary of State:

22           From Organ Donor Awareness Fund .....100,000

1           Section 130. The amount of \$500, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
3           from the Chicago and Northeast Illinois District Council of  
4           Carpenters Fund to provide grants for charitable purposes.

5           Section 135. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as  
6           may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
7           from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants  
8           for scholarships for Higher Education.

9           Section 140. The amount of \$700,000, or so much of this  
10          amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS  
11          Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State  
12          for the payment of any operational expenses relating to the  
13          cost incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor  
14          Vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the identity  
15          of drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for  
16          improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal  
17          Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed  
18          appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.

19          Section 145. The amount of \$2,333,500, or so much of this  
20          amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
21          the Secretary of State from the Securities Investors

1 Education Fund for any expenses used to promote public  
2 awareness of the dangers of securities fraud.

3 Section 150. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this  
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
5 the Secretary of State from the Secretary of State Evidence  
6 Fund for the purchase of evidence, for the employment of  
7 persons to obtain evidence, and for the payment for any goods  
8 or services related to obtaining evidence.

9 Section 155. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels  
11 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of  
12 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.

13 Section 160. The amount of \$17,124,000, or so much of  
14 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
15 Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the  
16 Secretary of State for office automation and technology.

17 Section 165. The amount of \$16,000,000, or so much of  
18 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
19 Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund to the Office of the  
20 Secretary of State for the cost incident to providing new or  
21 replacement plates for motor vehicles.

1           Section 170. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much of this  
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
3 Secretary of State DUI Administration Fund to the Office of  
4 Secretary of State for operation of the Department of  
5 Administrative Hearings of the Office of Secretary of State  
6 and for no other purpose.

7           Section 175. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State  
9 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of  
10 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of  
11 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

12           Section 180. The amount of \$250,000 is appropriated from  
13 the Secretary of State Police Services Fund to the Secretary  
14 of State for purposes as indicated by the grantor or  
15 contractor or, in the case of money bequeathed or granted for  
16 no specific purpose, for any purpose as deemed appropriate by  
17 the Director of Police, Secretary of State in administering  
18 the responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of  
19 Police.

20           Section 185. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of this  
21 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office



1 of the Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the  
 2 Secretary of State to be expended in accordance with the  
 3 terms and conditions upon which such funds were received.

4 Section 190. The amount of \$12,000, or so much of this  
 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
 6 the Secretary of State from the State Library Fund to  
 7 increase the collection of books, records, and holdings; to  
 8 hold public forums; to purchase equipment and resource  
 9 materials for the State Library; and for the upkeep, repair,  
 10 and maintenance of the State Library building and grounds.

11 Section 195. The following amount, or so much of this  
 12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
 13 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,  
 14 rehabilitations, new construction, and maintenance of the  
 15 interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities  
 16 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance  
 17 security measures in the Capitol Complex:

18 From General Revenue Fund .....3,500,000

19 Section 200. The amount of \$15,000,000, or so much of  
 20 that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
 21 Secretary of State Identification Security and Theft  
 22 Prevention Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for all

1 costs related to implementing identification security and  
2 theft prevention measures.

3 Section 205 The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of this  
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
5 Monitoring Device Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to  
6 the Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of  
7 State costs associated with administering Monitoring Device  
8 Driving Permits per Public Act 95-0400.

9 Section 210. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of this  
10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent  
11 BAIID Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to  
12 reimburse ignition interlock device providers per Public Act  
13 95-0400.

14 Section 215. The amount of \$25,000, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
16 from the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior  
17 Golf Fund for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers  
18 Association Foundation to help Association members expose  
19 Illinois youngsters to the game of golf.

20 Section 220. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State

1 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to  
2 support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public  
3 and private schools within Illinois.

4 Section 225. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
6 from the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the  
7 Illinois divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl  
8 Scouts of the U.S.A.

9 Section 230. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
11 from the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois  
12 Support Our Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the  
13 troops and their families in accordance with its Articles of  
14 Incorporation.

15 Section 235. The amount of \$300,000, or so much of this  
16 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
17 the Secretary of State from the Lobbyist Registration Fund  
18 for all costs associated with administering the Lobbyist  
19 Registration Act and the Secretary of State Act per Public  
20 Act 96-0555.

21 Section 240. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
2 the Secretary of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants  
3 for charitable purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

4 Section 245. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
6 the Secretary of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund  
7 for grants to the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for  
8 ovarian cancer research, education, screening, and treatment.

9 Section 250. The amount of \$3,000, or so much of this  
10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
11 the Secretary of State from the Sheet Metal Workers  
12 International Association of Illinois Fund for grants for  
13 charitable purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the  
14 Sheet Metal Workers International Association.

15 Section 255. The amount of \$20,000, or so much of this  
16 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
17 the Secretary of State from the Illinois Police Association  
18 Fund for providing death benefits for the families of police  
19 officers killed in the line of duty, and for providing  
20 scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or  
21 both, to children and spouses of police officers killed in  
22 the line of duty.

1           Section 260. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much of  
2 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the  
3 Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of State  
4 costs associated with the implementation of the provisions of  
5 Article XIV of the Illinois Constitution, including without  
6 limitation the duties under the Constitutional Convention Act  
7 and the Illinois Constitutional Amendment Act.

8           Section 265. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of  
10 business on June 30, 2010, from an appropriation heretofore  
11 made for such purpose in Article 140, Section 5 of Public Act  
12 96-0035, as amended, is reappropriated from the Build  
13 Illinois Bond Fund to the Secretary of State for capital  
14 grants to public libraries for permanent improvements.

15           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
16 2010.
