The amount of \$300,000, or so much of this 16 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of 17 the Secretary of State from the Lobbyist Registration Fund 18 for all costs associated with administering the Lobbyist 19 Registration Act and the Secretary of State Act per Public 20 Act 96-0555.

21 Section 240. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this

4 Section 245. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of 6 the Secretary of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund 7 for grants to the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for 8 ovarian cancer research, education, screening, and treatment.

9 Section 250. The amount of \$3,000, or so much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of 10 State from the 11 the Secretary of Sheet Metal Workers International Association of Illinois Fund for grants for 12 charitable purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the 13 14 Sheet Metal Workers International Association.

15 Section 255. The amount of \$20,000, or so much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of 16 the Secretary of State from the Illinois Police Association 17 18 Fund for providing death benefits for the families of police officers killed in the line of duty, and for providing 19 scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or 20 21 both, to children and spouses of police officers killed in 22 the line of duty.

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1 Section 260. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much of 2 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the 3 Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of State 4 costs associated with the implementation of the provisions of 5 Article XIV of the Illinois Constitution, including without 6 limitation the duties under the Constitutional Convention Act 7 and the Illinois Constitutional Amendment Act.

Section 265. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof 8 9 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2010, from an appropriation heretofore 10 made for such purpose in Article 140, Section 5 of Public Act 11 amended, is reappropriated from the 12 96-0035, as Build Illinois Bond Fund to the Secretary of State for capital 13 14 grants to public libraries for permanent improvements.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,16 2010.
