## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the state Comptroller for the salaries of certain state Officers for Fiscal Year 2011. Effective July 1, 2010.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 25. The amount of $\$ 1,598,100$, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller for contingencies in the event that any amounts appropriated
in Sections 5 through 20 of this Act are insufficient and other expenses associated with the administration of Sections 5 through 20.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2010.
