The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 4 5 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and grants for historic preservation programs made either 6 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 7 any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 8 or or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 9 10 private corporation, organization, or individual.

The sum of \$411,300, or so much thereof as 11 Section 25. may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 12 business on June 30, 2010, from appropriations heretofore 13 14 made for such purpose in Article 20, Sections 20 and 25 of Public Act 95-731, is reappropriated from the Illinois 15 16 Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and grants for historic preservation programs made 17 either independently or in cooperation with the Federal 18 19 Government or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 20 private corporation, organization, or individual. 21

Section 50. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 12 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for 13 operations, maintenance, repairs, permanent improvements, 14 15 special events, and all other costs related to the operation of Illinois Historic Sites and only to the extent which 16 donations are received at Illinois State Historic Sites. 17

18 Section 55. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be 19 necessary, is appropriated to the Historic Preservation 20 Agency from the General Revenue Fund for programs and 21 purposes including repairing, maintaining, reconstructing, 22 rehabilitating, replacing, fixed assets, construction and 23 development, studies, all costs for supplies, materials,

The sum of \$279,100, or so much thereof as Section 60. 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 4 5 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the operational expenses of the Lewis and Clark Historic Site in Madison 6 County. 7

8 Section 65. No contract shall be entered into or 9 obligation incurred for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from appropriations made in Section 55 10 of this Article until after the purposes and amounts have 11 been approved in writing by the Governor. 12
