SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Insurance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, as follows:

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AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the 8 Insurance Producer Administration Fund to the Department of 9 Insurance:

4 Section 10. The sum of \$536,300, or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance Producer 6 Administration Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs 7 and expenses related to or in support of a Regulatory/G&A 8 shared services center.

9 Section 15. In addition to other amounts appropriated 10 for these purposes, the amount of \$1,650,000, or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 12 Insurance Producer Administration Fund to the Department of 13 Insurance to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal 14 year ending June 30, 2011.

15 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much 16 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 17 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the 18 Insurance Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of 19 Insurance:

14 Section 25. The sum of \$567,000, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Insurance 16 Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for 17 costs and expenses related to or in support of a 18 Regulatory/G&A shared services center.

19 Section 30. In addition to other amounts appropriated 20 for these purposes, the amount of \$1,650,000, or so much 21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 22 Insurance Financial Regulation Fund to the Department of 23 Insurance to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal HB6800 -4- OMB096 00292 JEE 10293 b year ending June 30, 2011.

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2 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 4 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the 5 Public Pension Regulation Fund to the Department of 6 Insurance:

19 Section 40. The sum of \$2,272,600, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Senior Health 21 Insurance Program Fund to the Department of Insurance for the 22 administration of the Senior Health Insurance Program. 1 Section 45. The sum of \$485,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 3 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of 4 Insurance for costs associated with the administration and 5 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois 6 Workers' Compensation Commission's anti-fraud program.

7 Section 50. In addition to other amounts appropriated 8 for these purposes, the amount of \$557,000, or so much 9 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public 10 Pension Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance to 11 meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 12 30, 2011.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,14 2010.

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
