HOUSE RESOLUTION 163

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES RESOLVED, BY THE ΟF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that there is created a task force to study local government development standards and processes and their effect on watershed, wetlands, and floodplains. The task force shall consist of the following members: 4 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, one of whom shall be appointed to serve as co-chairperson; 4 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Minority Leader of the House, one of whom shall be appointed to serve as co-chairperson; and at least one representative appointed by the majority of the members of the task force from each of the following: a statewide organization representing municipal interests, a land conservation entity, and a property development entity; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the goal of the task force is to secure improved management practices in local government development standards, with a focus on all of the following:

- (1) Local government development practices and the short-term and long-term impact on lands affected and subsequent property owners.
- (2) Topics of mass grading, compensatory storage, drainage, runoff, bank stabilization, diversion of flood
