- 5 WHEREAS, Laura was born on February 26, 1982; she graduated 6 from Bradley Bourbonnais High School in 2000 and from Bradley 7 University in 2004; she was a two-time, first-team All-American 8 at Kankakee Community College; and named Bradley University's 9 Most Outstanding female athlete in 2004; and
- WHEREAS, While attending Bradley University she started
 every game in her two-year span as a Brave where she was a
 two-time All-Missouri Valley Conference selection; she
 compiled a career batting average of .353, which ranks second
 overall in school history, while her 135 hits during her tenure
 at Bradley is the most for any Brave during a two-year span;

- WHEREAS, In 2005 she scored the first run in Chicago Bandit history; and
- 19 WHEREAS, In 2008 she completed her fourth season with the 20 Chicago Bandits and is an original member of the team since 21 their formation in 2005; she hit .234 with 26 hits, 14 runs,
