1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives recognize young children as one of the State's 4 most precious and valuable resources; and

WHEREAS, The National Association for the Education of Young Children is the nation's largest early childhood organization; the association seeks to serve and act on behalf of the rights, needs, and well-being of all young children, with a primary focus on the provision of educational and developmental needs and services; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Association for the Education of Young Children (ILAEYC) is the state affiliate of the National Association for the Education of Young Children; ILAEYC has over 4,000 members and 17 local affiliate chapters around the State dedicated to the same mission; and

WHEREAS, The National Association for the Education of Young Children has designated the week of April 12-16 as the Week of the Young Child; the month of April is designated as Month of the Young Child in the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Month of the Young Child is to focus public attention on the needs of young children and their

- 13 Mark McHugh of Chicago, Alice Giordano of Glen Ellyn, Nancy
- Morse of Urbana, Maureen Sollars of Bloomington, Martha Owens
- of Milan, Linda Davis of Lockport, Diane King of Carbondale,
- 16 and Mary Nan Zimmer of Neoga represent shining examples of
- 17 those in our communities doing good things for children; these
- 18 individuals have been nominated by their local affiliate
- 19 chapters and designated by the Illinois Association for the
- 20 Education of Young Children as Illinois 2010 Children's
