1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 750

AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 750, AS AMENDED, 2 3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No. 4, by replacing everything from line 18 on page 2 to line 11 on 4 5 page 3 with the following: "(b-5) In fiscal year 2010, no appropriation made from 6 7 General funds to the State Board of Education, the Board of Higher Education, the Community College Board, the Student 8 9 Assistance Commission, or any public university may be decreased from its fiscal year 2009 general appropriation 10 level. An exception may be made only if a program's 11 12 appropriation is based on actual cost and that cost has been determined by the Board or university to require a lesser 13 14 appropriation; however, the aggregate appropriation to those 15 Boards or universities for fiscal year 2010 shall not under any circumstances represent a decrease from the fiscal year 2009 16 17 aggregate general fund appropriation level for that Board or

- (b-10) Beginning in fiscal year 2011 and in each fiscal 1 year thereafter, in addition to the amounts required to be 2 transferred under subsection (b), an amount equal to the first 3 4 40% of the amount of additional revenue generated through the 5 taxes imposed by this amendatory Act of the 96th General 6 Assembly in that fiscal year shall be transferred from the General Revenue Fund to the Common School Fund. In addition, 7 beginning in fiscal year 2011 and in each fiscal year 8 9 thereafter, an amount equal to the next 10% of the amount of 10 additional revenue generated through those taxes shall be 11 transferred from the General Revenue Fund to the Higher 12 Education Fund. 13 (b-15) The Higher Education Fund is created as a special 14 fund in the State treasury. Moneys in this Fund may be used 15 only for purposes related to higher education. The Higher Education Fund is not subject to administrative charges that 16 would in any way transfer any funds from the Higher Education 17
