Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Marriage and Dissolution of 5 Marriage Act is amended by changing Section 105 as follows:
- (750 ILCS 5/105) (from Ch. 40, par. 105) 6
- 7 Sec. 105. Application of Civil Practice Law.)
- (a) The The provisions of the Civil Practice Law shall 8 9 apply to all proceedings under this Act, except as otherwise provided in this Act.
- (b) A proceeding for dissolution of marriage, legal 11 separation or declaration of invalidity of marriage shall be 12 entitled "In re the Marriage of ... and ...". A custody or 13 14 support proceeding shall be entitled "In re the (Custody)
- (Support) of ...". 15

- 16 (c) The initial pleading in all proceedings under this Act
- 17 shall be denominated a petition. A responsive pleading shall be
- denominated a response. All other pleadings under this Act 18
- shall be denominated as provided in the Civil Practice Law. 19
