

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 SB0937

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-645

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning Vietnam Veteran license plates.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3-645 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-645)
- 7 Sec. 3-645. Vietnam Veteran License Plates.
- 8 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the the 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 10 issue Vietnam Veteran license plates to residents of Illinois 11 who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary 12 of State. The special Vietnam Veteran plate issued under this 13 14 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 15 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 16 17 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 18 19 Code.
- 20 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 21 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 22 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 23 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with

- 1 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to
- designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of
- 3 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the
- 4 eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall
- 5 approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under
- 6 Section 3-412.
- 7 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original
- 8 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This
- 9 additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State
- 10 Special License Plate Fund.
