- Section 10. "Professional and artistic services" defined. 9
- For the purposes of this amendatory Act of the 96th General 10
- Assembly, the term "professional and artistic services" means 11
- those services provided under contract to a State agency by a 12
- person or business, acting as an independent contractor, 13
- qualified by education, experience, and technical ability. 14

- Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 16
- the amount of \$371,000, or so much thereof as may be 17
- 18 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- the Legislative Information System for operational expenses, 19
- awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the fiscal 20

ARTICLE 3 2

No money 9 be transferred into or out of this line item. 10

ARTICLE 4 11

In addition to other amounts appropriated, the amount of \$407,200, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for operational 15 expenses, awards, grants, state matching grant purposes, and 16 17 permanent improvements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended for professional 18 and artistic services. No money may be transferred into or 19 20 out of this line item.

Section 25. In addition to other amounts appropriated, 2 3 the amount of \$1,993,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 4 5 the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor for operational expenses, awards, grants, state matching grant 6 purposes, and permanent improvements for the fiscal year 7 ending June 30, 2010, except that no amounts may be expended 8 for professional and artistic services. No money may be 9 10 transferred into or out of this line item.

No money may 10 be transferred into or out of this line item. 11
