

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 SB1379

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

605 ILCS 5/6-411

from Ch. 121, par. 6-411

Amends the Illinois Highway Code. Provides that in townships with a population of less than 15,000, a highway commissioner may have a pecuniary interest in lease contracts if the aggregate total of the contracts is less than \$2,000 (rather than \$1,000) in the same fiscal year with the approval of the town board of trustees or the highway board of auditors. Effective immediately.

- 7 Sec. 6-411. Pecuniary interest in leases. In townships with
- 8 a population of less than 15,000, with the approval of the town
- 9 board of trustees or the highway board of auditors, as the case
- 10 may be, a highway commissioner may have a pecuniary interest in
- 11 lease contracts if the aggregate total of those contracts is
- less than  $$2,000 \frac{$1,000}{}$  in the same fiscal year.
