410 ILCS 535/18.5

Amends the Vital Records Act. Provides that upon the State Registrar's establishment of an electronic reporting system for death registrations, the county clerk in the county in which a death occurred or the county clerk of the county where a decedent last resided shall be authorized to issue certifications of death records from the system and the State Registrar shall cause the system to provide for such capability. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning public health.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Vital Records Act is amended by changing
Section 18.5 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 535/18.5)

7 18.5. Electronic reporting system Sec. for death registrations. The State Registrar may facilitate 8 death 9 registration by implementing an electronic reporting system. 10 The system may be used to transfer information to individuals 11 institutions responsible for completing and and filing certificates and related reports for deaths that occur in the 12 State. The system shall be capable of storing and retrieving 13 14 accurate and timely data and statistics for those persons and agencies responsible for vital records registration 15 and 16 administration. Upon establishment of such an electronic 17 reporting system, the county clerk in the county in which a 18 death occurred or the county clerk of the county where a 19 decedent last resided shall be authorized to issue 20 certifications of death records from such system, and the State 21 Registrar shall cause the electronic reporting system to 22 provide for such capability.
