## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Vital Records Act is amended by changing Section 18.5 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 535/18.5)
- 7 18.5. Electronic reporting system for death registrations. The State Registrar may facilitate 8 9 registration by implementing an electronic reporting system. 10 The system may be used to transfer information to individuals 11 institutions responsible for completing and certificates and related reports for deaths that occur in the 12 State. The system shall be capable of storing and retrieving 13 14 accurate and timely data and statistics for those persons and agencies responsible for vital records registration 15 16 administration. Upon establishment of such an electronic 17 reporting system, but not later than January 1, 2011, the county clerk in the county in which a death occurred or the 18 19 county clerk of the county where a decedent last resided, as 20 indicated on the decedent's death certificate, shall be 21 authorized to issue certifications of death records from such 22 system, and the State Registrar shall cause the electronic reporting system to provide for such capability. 23
