1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended by changing Section 12 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/12) (from Ch. 23, par. 5012)
- 7 12. (a) provide To supervision, 8 accommodations, board or the payment of boarding costs, 9 tuition, and treatment free of charge, except as otherwise specified in this Act, for residents of this State who are 10 cared for in any institution, or for persons receiving services 11 under any program under the jurisdiction of the Department. 12 13 Residents of other states may be admitted upon payment of the 14 costs of board, tuition, and treatment as determined by the Department; provided, that no resident of another state shall 15 16 be received or retained to the exclusion of any resident of 17 this State. The Department shall accept any donation for the board, tuition, and treatment of any person receiving service 18 19 or care.
- 20 (b) By July 1, 1994, to make room and board payments to
 21 persons providing foster care under this Act at a rate for each
 22 child that is up to 100% of the adjusted United States
 23 Department of Agriculture Cost of Raising a Child in the Urban

Midwest/Low Cost Index. 1

- 2 (c) The Department shall work with representatives of 3 voluntary foster care providers and foster parents to determine rates to be paid to foster parents of wards of the State for 4 5 State fiscal year 2010 that will equitably distribute moneys appropriated to the Department to fund an increase in the cost 6 of care reimbursement rate for foster parents according to a 7 8 national methodology such as the Foster Care MARC (Minimum 9 Adequate Rates for Children) developed by the Children's 10 Rights/National Foster Parent Association and the University 11 of Maryland School of Social Work. On and after July 1, 2009, 12 the Department shall work with such representatives to establish a methodology for calculating foster caregiver 13 14 reimbursement rates that shall include an annual review of the cost of care provided by foster parents and increases in the 15 16 Consumer Price Index. The Department shall adopt rules for the 17 development and review of the methodology no later than January 18 1, 2010.
