1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding Section 31-4.5 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/31-4.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 31-4.5. Obstructing identification.</u>
- 8 (a) A person commits the offense of obstructing
- 9 identification when he or she intentionally or knowingly
- 10 <u>furnishes a false or fictitious name, residence address, or</u>
- 11 date of birth to a peace officer who has:
- 12 (1) lawfully arrested the person;
- 13 (2) lawfully detained the person; or
- 14 (3) requested the information from a person that the
- peace officer has good cause to believe is a witness to a
- 16 criminal offense.
- 17 <u>(b) Sentence. Obstructing identification is a Class A</u>
- 18 misdemeanor.
