## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 3605/53 new 70 ILCS 3605/54 new 70 ILCS 3615/3A.17 new 70 ILCS 3615/3A.18 new 70 ILCS 3615/3B.16 new 70 ILCS 3615/3B.17 new 70 ILCS 3615/5.06 new

Amends the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act and the Regional Transportation Authority Act. Provides that the Regional Transportation Authority must implement a single fare card system to allow senior citizens aged 65 and older who reside within the metropolitan region to use all transit services provided by the Chicago Transit Authority, the Suburban Bus Division, and the Commuter Rail Division free of charge. Sets forth certain criteria for the fare cards. Provides that it is a Class A misdemeanor for an applicant to provide false information on an application for a senior citizen fare card. Provides that the Chicago Transit Authority, the Suburban Bus Division, and the Commuter Rail Division must provide transit services free of charge to active duty military personnel who are in uniform. Effective immediately.

Sec. 5.06. Senior citizen fare cards. Within 60 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly, the Authority must implement a single fare card system to allow senior citizens aged 65 and older who reside within the metropolitan region to use all transit services provided by the Chicago Transit Authority, the Suburban Bus Division, and the Commuter Rail Division free of charge. 1	Authority must promulgate rules to implement the fare card
2	system, which shall include, at a minimum, the following:
3	(1) each applicant shall be required to submit an
4	application only once and shall not be required to reapply;
5	(2) applicants must be legal residents of Illinois; and
6	(3) applicants must certify that their income is equal
7	to or less than 400% of the federal poverty line, as
8	determined by the federal Office of Management and Budget.
9	Any applicant who knowingly provides false information on
10	an application for a senior citizen fare card commits a Class A
11	misdemeanor.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 13 becoming law.
