

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
5 Sections 1-168.8 and 11-1427.5 and changing Section 1-101.8 as  
6 follows:

7 (625 ILCS 5/1-101.8) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-102.02)

8 Sec. 1-101.8. All-terrain vehicle. Any motorized  
9 off-highway device designed to travel primarily off-highway,  
10 50 inches or less in width, having a manufacturer's dry weight  
11 of 1,500 ~~900~~ pounds or less, traveling on 3 or more non-highway  
12 ~~low-pressure~~ tires, designed with a seat or saddle for operator  
13 use, and handlebars or steering wheel for steering control,  
14 except equipment such as lawnmowers.

16 (625 ILCS 5/1-168.8 new)

17 Sec. 1-168.8. Recreational off-highway vehicle. Any  
18 motorized off-highway device designed to travel primarily  
19 off-highway, 64 inches or less in width, having a  
20 manufacturer's dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less, traveling on  
21 4 or more non-highway tires, designed with a non-straddle seat  
22 and a steering wheel for steering control, except equipment

1 such as lawnmowers.

2 (625 ILCS 5/11-1427.5 new)

3 Sec. 11-1427.5. Recreational off-highway vehicles. All  
4 provisions of this Code that apply to an all-terrain vehicle  
5 shall apply the same to a recreational off-highway vehicle.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
7 becoming law.
