AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

Section 5. The Illinois Migrant Labor Camp Law is amended 4 5 by changing Section 3 as follows:

(210 ILCS 110/3) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 185.3) 6

7 Sec. 3. No person shall operate or maintain a Migrant Labor Camp within the State of Illinois without first having obtained 8 9 a license therefor from the Department. Licenses shall be issued prior to operation upon a calendar year basis and 10 renewed from year to year upon compliance with the requirements 11 12 this Act and payment of the annual license fee. of Establishments that provide housing for migrant workers for 13 14 fewer than 10 migrant workers or fewer than 4 families containing migrant workers shall meet the minimum standards 15 16 established by the Department but shall not be required to be 17 licensed.
