#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$500,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant to CommunityHealth to do the following: (1) increase the number of individuals served by 15% (from 7,360 to 8,500) and the number of medical visits by 17% (from 20,600 to 24,000); (2) expand the number of specialty services available on site by 19% (from 24 to 28); (3) increase the number of training programs on site by 63% (from 8 to 13); and (4) open a satellite site on the south side of Chicago. Effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
6 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant to  
7 CommunityHealth to do the following:

8 (1) increase the number of individuals served by 15%  
9 (from 7,360 to 8,500) and the number of medical visits by  
10 17% (from 20,600 to 24,000);

11 (2) expand the number of specialty services available  
12 on site by 19% (from 24 to 28);

13 (3) increase the number of training programs on site  
14 by 63% (from 8 to 13); and

15 (4) open a satellite site on the south side of  
16 Chicago.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
