SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/19-1	from Ch. 46, par. 19-1
10 ILCS 5/19-2	from Ch. 46, par. 19-2
10 ILCS 5/19-3	from Ch. 46, par. 19-3
10 ILCS 5/19-5	from Ch. 46, par. 19-5

Amends the Election Code. Permits a person to request and vote an absentee ballot without specifying a reason for the absence from the polling place on election day. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
5 Sections 19-1, 19-2, 19-3, and 19-5 as follows:

8 having duly registered where such registration is required ~~who~~
~~will be unable to enter his or her precinct polling place~~

~~or who expects to be absent from the county in which he is a~~
~~qualified elector or who because of being appointed a judge of~~
~~election in a precinct other than the precinct in which he~~
~~resides or who because of physical incapacity or the tenets of~~
~~his religion in the observance of a religious holiday or who~~
~~because of election duties for the office of an Election~~
~~Authority or the State Board of Elections or who because of~~
~~election duties for a law enforcement agency, including but not~~
~~limited to the offices of the Attorney General, a State's~~
~~Attorney, a United States Attorney, or a State, county, or~~
~~municipal police department, or who, because he is temporarily~~
~~abiding outside the precinct in which he is registered to vote~~

9 ~~which questions of public policy are submitted, may vote at~~

11 ~~Each Election Authority, law enforcement agency, and the~~
12 ~~State Board of Elections shall compile and keep current a list~~
13 ~~of his or its officers or employees who are eligible to vote~~
14 ~~under this Article by reason of election duties.~~

15 For purposes of this Article 19, a physically incapacitated
16 voter marks his or her ballot "personally" when the voter
17 exercises his or her physical abilities to their reasonable
18 limit in marking the ballot, and marking personally may include
19 instructing the person assisting the incapacitated voter when
20 giving such instruction represents the reasonable limit of the
21 physical abilities.

violating Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code of 1961 or who is expecting to be absent from the county of his residence or any such elector who because of being appointed a judge of election in a precinct other than the precinct in which he resides or who because of physical incapacity or the tenets of his religion in the observance of a religious holiday or who because of election duties for the office of an Election Authority, the State Board of Elections, or a law enforcement agency, or who because of his or her confinement or detention in a jail pending acquittal or conviction of a crime, will be unable to be present at the polls on the day of such election may by mail, not more than 40 nor less than 5 days prior to the date of such election, or by personal delivery not more than 40 nor less than one day prior to the date of such election, make application to the county clerk or to the Board of Election Commissioners for an official ballot for the voter's precinct to be voted at such election.

23 agent of the voter's union, when the voter's physical
24 incapacity necessitates such assistance.

25 Provided, that if the ballot enclosed is to be voted at a
26 primary election, the certification shall designate the name of

1 the political party with which the voter is affiliated.

2 In addition to the above, the election authority shall
3 provide printed slips giving full instructions regarding the
4 manner of marking and returning the ballot in order that the
5 same may be counted, and shall furnish one of such printed
6 slips to each of such applicants at the same time the ballot is
7 delivered to him. Such instructions shall include the following
8 statement: "In signing the certification on the absentee ballot
9 envelope, you are attesting that you personally marked this
10 absentee ballot in secret. If you are physically unable to mark
11 the ballot, a friend or relative may assist you after
12 completing the enclosed affidavit. Federal and State laws
13 prohibit a candidate whose name appears on the ballot (unless
14 you are the spouse or a parent, child, brother, or sister of
15 the candidate), your employer, your employer's agent or an
16 officer or agent of your union from assisting physically
17 disabled voters."

18 In addition to the above, if a ballot to be provided to an
19 elector pursuant to this Section contains a public question
20 described in subsection (b) of Section 28-6 and the territory
21 concerning which the question is to be submitted is not
22 described on the ballot due to the space limitations of such
23 ballot, the election authority shall provide a printed copy of
24 a notice of the public question, which shall include a
25 description of the territory in the manner required by Section
26 16-7. The notice shall be furnished to the elector at the same

1 time the ballot is delivered to the elector.
